General Information & Conditions of Entry

General Information

1. Entry Form must be completed honestly, accurately, legibly and **SIGNED**.
2. Use only one entry form per person.
3. To be eligible competitors must hold a ranking no higher than 1st Kyu. Black Belts and above are ineligible.
4. **AGE IS DETERMINED BY THE AGE A COMPETITOR WILL BE ON 10th September 2004**
5. If under 18 years of age, entry forms must be signed by a **Parent or Guardians**
6. W.K.F. (World Karate Federation) rules will be applied to this tournament and modified at the discretion of the organisers.
7. Competitors are responsible for their own Public Liability & Professional Indemnity Insurance including Participation (Member to Member) & Sports Injury/Accident cover.
8. Juniors may NOT enter more than one (1) age category.
9. The organisers reserve the right to combine or cancel divisions where there are insufficient entries.
10. Athletes can compete in both Veterans and Senior individual divisions.

Kumite

1. Bouts for Children, Cadet, Junior and Womens' Kumite divisions will be 2 minutes. Senior male 3 minutes.
2. For divisions 15 Years and Under there will be an absolute rule of 'No contact' to the head.

COMPULSORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- a. AKF approved or/WKF approved red and blue Hand Mitts, Groin Guards (Males) and Mouthguards – **All competitors.**
- b. AKF approved combined Shin/Instep Protectors – **All competitors 17 years of age and under.**

OPTIONAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- a. AKF approved or/WKF approved shin protectors - **18 years and older**
- b. Chest protection – females.

Kata

1. Flag System to be used.
2. Children, Cadet, Junior & Senior **Kyu Grade** – **Must have minimum two Kata. May repeat but not in consecutive rounds.**
