### FORM 3

#### General Information

1. Entry Form must be completed honestly, accurately, legibly and **SIGNED BY EACH TEAM MEMBER**.
2. Use only **one** entry form per team.
3. **AGE IS DETERMINED BY THE AGE A COMPETITOR WILL BE ON 10<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2004**
4. If under 18 years of age, entry forms must be signed by a **Parent or Guardian**.
5. W.K.F. (World Karate Federation) rules will be applied to this tournament and modified at the discretion of the organisers.
6. Competitors are responsible for their own Public Liability & Professional Indemnity Insurance including Participation (Member to Member) & Sports Injury / Accident cover.
7. The organisers reserve the right to combine or cancel divisions where there are insufficient entries.

#### Kumite

1. For divisions 15 years and under there will be an absolute rule of 'No contact' to the head.
2. Bouts for Children, Cadet, Junior and Womens' Kumite divisions will be 2 minutes. Senior male 3 minutes.

#### COMPULSORY SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- a. AKF approved or/WKF approved red and blue Hand Mits Groin Guards (Males) and Mouthguards – **All Competitors**.
- b. AKF approved combined Shin/Instep Protectors – **All competitors 17 years of age and under**.

#### OPTIONAL SAFETY EQUIPMENT

- a. AKF approved or/WKF approved shin protectors - **18 years and older**
- b. Chest protection – females.

#### Kata

1. Flag system will be used.
2. Must have minimum two Kata. Free choice Kata for all teams. May repeat Kata but not in consecutive rounds. The two finalist teams will perform their chosen Kata and will then perform a demonstration of the meaning of the Kata (Bunkai). The time allowed for the Bunkai demonstration is five minutes.

- e) "The Rules" means the rules for the time being of the Australian Karate Federation Incorporated.
